We're easy to get to. By road, by train or by aeroplane.

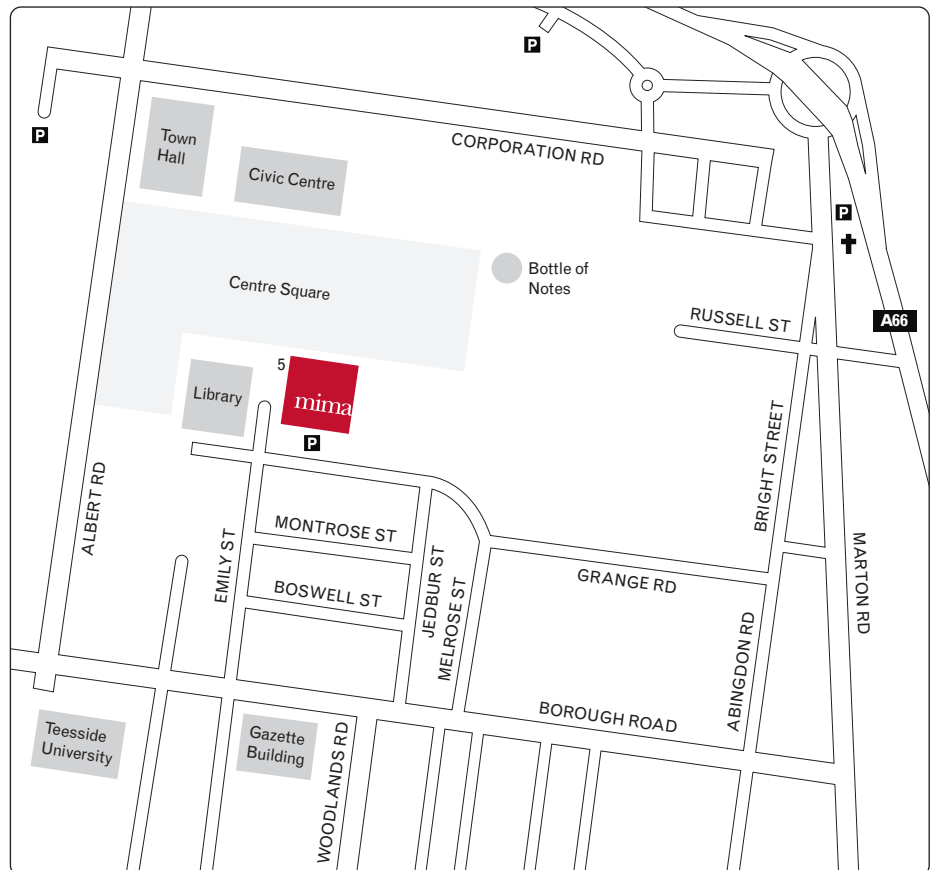
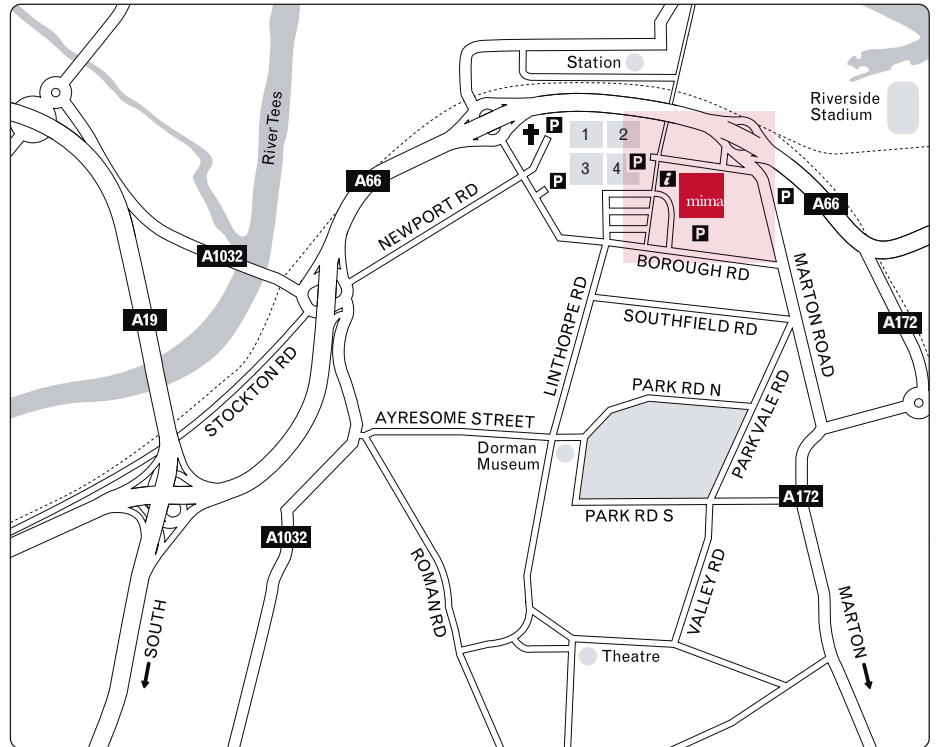
By road: Take the A19, turn off onto the A66 and follow the signs for the town centre. Newcastle, Sunderland, Durham and York are under an hour. Leeds is a little further. Direct bus services don't take much longer. There are plenty of car parks within five minutes walk of mima.

By train: use the East Coast mainline to get to Darlington, then jump on a local service heading towards Saltburn (this ride takes about 20 minutes).

By air: Durham Tees Valley International Airport is 20 minutes away (with direct links to London, Paris, Rome, Amsterdam, Bristol, Dublin, Aberdeen and more.)
